- 1.4.4. Wreath Fundraiser: We were unable to arrange for pick up in Courtenay with a truck or trailer this year, so the wreath fundraiser is not happening. We have reached out to Hilltop Greenhouses, who run 2 fundraisers every year a Mother's Day fundraiser and a winter poinsettia fundraiser. 5.1. Fiscal Year 2022-23

5.3. Proposed Bylaw Change: That the bylaw change that would allow the Treasurer to be one of the cheque signers. Right now, there are three other people with signing authority besides me, and I need two of them to sign every

cheque. As changes to Bylaws require more notice, a motion will be proposed next PAC General Meeting in January.

Current Bylaw:

9.7 The Executive will appoint three signing officers from the membership, in addition to the Treasurer, for banking and legal documents including cheques. The President, Vice-President, and Secretary may service in this capacity. Two different signatures are required on all of these documents. Neither the person preparing cheques (typically the Treasurer) nor the person to whom the cheque is issued may act as a signing officer for those cheques.

Suggested change:

9.7 The Executive will appoint three signing officers from the membership, in addition to the Treasurer, for banking and legal documents including cheques. The President, Vice-President, and Secretary may service in this capacity. Two different signatures are required on all of these documents. The person to whom the cheque is issued may not act as a signing officer for those cheques. Cheques must be fully filled out before being signed, i.e., no blank cheques.

- **5.4. Reimbursement Form:** Made a new reimbursement form Sarah distributed to staff and paper copies available in office.
- **5.5. Gaming Report:** Will submit Gaming Report this week.
- 6. SECRETARY'S REPORT (Kendall Salahub)
 - district's recommended emergency supplies, including replacing food and water expiring in 2023 will cost about \$4,500 and includes first aid supplies, communication equipment, replacing food and water, tarp, rope, honey buckets and mylar emergency blankets. Phase 2 will include a range of tools, batteries, candles and flares and cost up to \$1,500. Phase 2 should also include extra warm clothing, comfort items for kids and teachers, which have not been included in this \$1,500 estimate. Recommend that next Clothing Swap we keep extras with emergency supplies, and consider expanding the donation wish list to include playing cards, small toys/stuffed animals and sleeping bags.
