Principal's Report: Presenter Melanie

- Staff package submitted, allotted 27 division
 - No staff layoffs
 - increase of .1 administration time,
 - increase of library time
 - priority for staff is to keep the music room allowing for teacher prep time in their classrooms
 - we will be losing the parent room to classroom space
- 1-2 portables will be added there is currently one available, likely to be placed near the front of the school
- Queens Street play area will be repaved adding to the accessibility grant
- 2020/2021 school year George Jay will have a daycare
- Negotiations are happening with before and after school care, perhaps portable will be installed for 2019/2020 school year to be used as a classroom
- JonPaul from the district will build accessible sandbox at cost
- Literacy week was a huge success and well embraced by students. Thank you to Mme. Rebecca and Kathy Carter for spearheading the project!
- PISE is coming and playing/teaching world cup soccer with students during recess
- Track will be starting up

Finanacial Update: Presenter Kim

\$500 will be used for the emergency box to buy tarps and other necessary supplies

City Update: Presenter Angela

- George Jay is the only school in Victoria that will take part in Ready, Set, Roll
- Intersections at Chambers and Bay, Cook and Princess, and Chambers and Princess will be fitted with lighted cross-walks

- Discussed having a flexible barrier on Queens St. To help facilitate a drop and go zone
- Mayor Helps is considering expanding the school zone to improve student safety
- Efforts to reinstate police liaison program are happening
- Councilor Dubow will come and do a walk around the school to discuss safety issues and concerns
- We are getting a lot of support from the city

Health and Wellness Update

- Longer lasting veggies are being chosen. Staff says that they are running out and it is very popular with students.
- Cutting schedule may be needed with parent volunteer sign-up sheet
- There has been confusion over where funds come from, \$500 from PAC +\$1000 from Optimists Club (through PAC) + \$1000 from Harbourside Rotary for Parent Education
- Action: Lilli will go through past PAC minutes and review financial decisions to determine which accounts will cover expenses
- Motion to make Health and Wellness would like to be a subcommittee
 - Action: approved
- H &W would like more opportunities to fundraise beyond Fundscript to help expand programs
 - Motion to add SPUD fundraiser (this will not interfere with Good Food Box program)
 - Action: Approved
- Administration needs information on fundraising opportunities
 - Action: H &W will send info to admin to be emailed to parents and added to newsletter
- Fundscript fundraiser will be split 50/50 between H&W and PAC
- SPUD fundraiser will go directly to H&W budget

Inclusive Playground Concerns: Presenter Lilli

- We still have over \$15,000 available for inclusive playground equipment
- Currently, there is very little for wheelchair bound children to participate in on the playground
- We should consider attaching tactile toys to the railings next to the basketball courts as these
 are lower in cost and beneficial to those with mobility issues as well as children with sensory
 issues

Monks Fundraiser: Presenter Kim

- No fundraiser has been established for this year, this will leave a huge hole in the PAC fundraising
- Leila will not have extra supplies for students in need
- We are still waiting on district approval of supply lists, we had it in February of last year
- Sarah, our Monk representative is working setting it up. We have typically had supplies delivered by the end of the school year but there is not enough time for that to happen this year
- Motion to have supplies delivered at the beginning of the 2019/2020 school year
 - -Action: Passed

Gym Equipment: Presenter Angela

- The gym needs new basketballs and soccer balls as well as cones
- Could we apply for a Canadian Tire Jump Start Grant? Grants can be applied to between Feb. 1st through Nov. 1st.
- Lilli will talk to Kirby's for discounted rate

Budget and AGM Discussion
